### *A typical day at Cozy Cat Cottage*

Busy, to say the least!

A day at Cozy Cat Cottage begins early with feeding, administering medications, and checking on those that were recently spayed or neutered. Cleaning dozens of litter boxes is also part of the morning routine, along with sweeping floors, and freshening blankets in the enclosures.

Before the staff leaves for the evening, the routine is repeated, and some cats even go home with the staff if they need special attention.

Yes, it is a big job, but you will not hear complaints because caring for these cats is also a labor of love.

You see, everyone at Cozy Cat Cottage knows each kitten and cat by name (yes, they are all named). They know each cat's likes and dislikes, who get along with whom, those that are bonded, little quirks, and how they came to Cozy Cat Cottage.

In short, the team at Cozy Cat Cottage loves each cat that comes to the shelter. In fact, the only thing the staff loves more than seeing them each day is learning they have found a loving, forever home.
